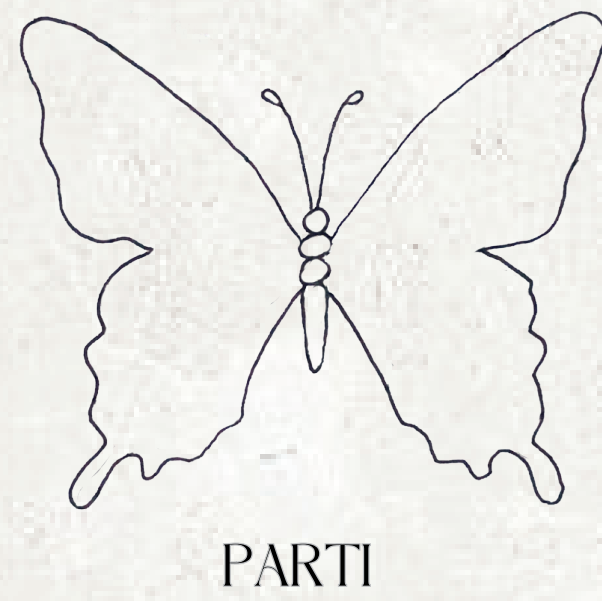
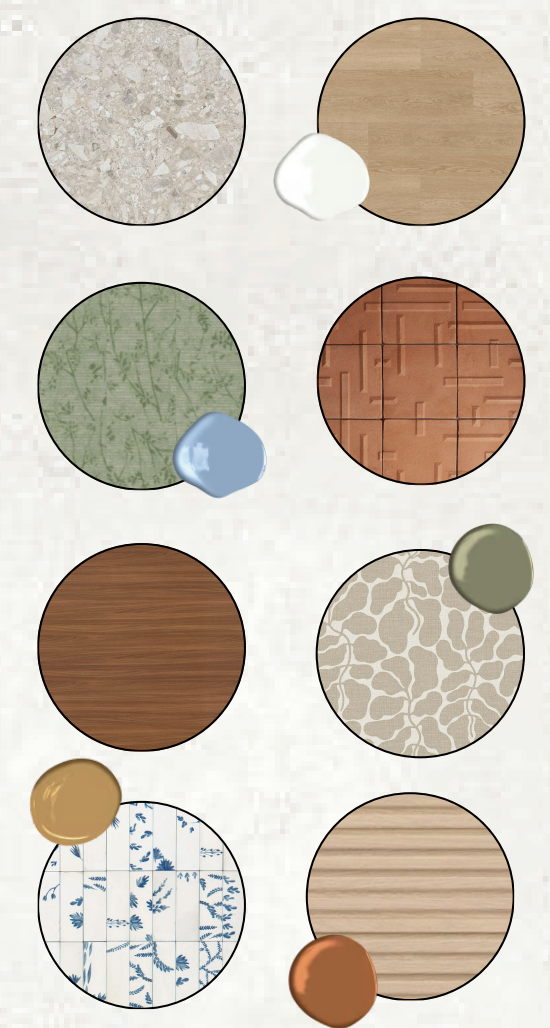


# THE MONARCH

The project's focus is on eating disorder recovery in both youth and young adults as this age group is the most affected. The eating disorder recovery centre will focus on creating a supportive and therapeutic environment for individuals undergoing treatment and recovery. In the community there are limited treatment options, these being only therapy and group therapy which not all individuals find helpful. There are no other types of help that don't involve hospitalisation. Many individuals do not want to go to a recovery centre because of the clinical and cold feeling these buildings are known for having or from having poor experiences in the past. The hope for this centre is to create a place that people feel welcomed to heal with the support of staff and loved ones.



The parti for The Monarch is a butterfly. Butterflies symbolise recovery and hold a personal meaning to me specifically which is why it was chosen as the logo and parti for the centre. The various organic curves within the building layout will help create a sense of comfort and flow within the building layout as well as adding interest. By adding curvilinear forms within the design, it helps to stray away from typical clinics and centres with straight forms which can feel cold and clinical.

### DESIGN INTENT

The intent for the centre is to create a space where youth and young adults can recover in a safe and comfortable environment. The goal for the design is to create different areas that can be used for treatments such as art therapy, yoga and training kitchens. As well as including inpatient treatments rooms and spaces for families to spend time with their child during their stay. Including activities and various therapy options in the centre are imperative to aiding youths/young adults recovery and provides them a sense of freedom to find what works best for them. The importance of having an eating disorder recovery centre available to youths and young adults is to assure everyone has a safe place to heal and grow without feeling any fear or anxiety. The end goal for this project is to create a comfortable and non judgemental space where youths/young adults can go to heal and find the type of treatment that works best for them.
